Ellis, who has experience working with sharks (he did 2nd unit on DEEP BLUE SEA) and dimensional gore (THE FINAL DESTINATION). The script was written by Jesse Studenberg and Will Hayes, and the film will be produced by Lynette Howell and TEXAS CHAINSAW MASSACRE's Mike Fleiss and Chris Briggs. It'll be racing BAIT, a Russell Mulcahy flick about tiger sharks invading a tsunami-flooded supermarket that's currently in the works, to 3-D screens.
