[Cemetery Dance](#) has announced that the exclusive \$25 trade hardcover will be released April 20. The book features cover artwork by Glen Orbik and eight pieces of interior art by Alex McVey. BLOCKADE BILLY is the "true story" of William "Blockade Billy" Blakely, who may have been the greatest player the game has ever seen, but today no one remembers his name. He was the first (and only) baseballer to have his existence completely removed from the record books. Even his team is long forgotten, barely a footnote in sports history. Every effort was made to erase any evidence that William Blakely played professional ball, and with good reason. Blockade Billy had a secret darker than any pill or injection that might cause a scandal in sports today. His secret was much, much worse...

King says of this latest work, "I love old-school baseball, and I also love the way people who've spent a lifetime in the game talk about the game. I tried to combine those things in a story of suspense. People have asked me for years when I was going to write a baseball story. Ask no more; this is it."
